The service is available to women in Western Australia who have previously, or who are currently, experiencing intimate partner financial abuse, in connection with consumer credit and debt, as well as Australian Consumer Law matters.

Our service integrates the expertise of both a consumer credit lawyer and a case worker.

Consumer Credit issues we may be able to assist with include:

- Joint debts and accounts
- Hardship
- Debts accrued in the client's name without their knowledge or consent
- Pressure to sign contracts and personal guarantees
- Debt Collection
- Credit files
